WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Fire District 2, Lower Township, Cape May County, New Jersey have determined that they are in possession of a 1976 Dodge Brush Truck (Mini Pumper) designated Unit 6121 that is in need of extensive repairs and the services it once provided have been incorporated into other equipment and apparatus; and,

WHEREAS, NJSA 40A:11-36 provides for the methodology for disposing of the aforesaid office furniture and 1976 Dodge Brush Truck,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Fire District No. 2, in the Township of Lower, County of Cape May that the aforesaid office furniture and 1976 Dodge Brush Truck be disposed of and removed from the Fire District's inventory as provided for at NJSA 40A:11-36; and.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the appropriate Commissioners are authorized to execute any actions or documents required to perform the disposal.
